# A Literary Review study of Kaphakunjar Rasa

## **Abstract:**

In Ayurvedic classics reference of *Kaphakunjar Rasa* is found in three texts i.e. *YogRatnakar*, *Brihat RasaRaj Sundar* and *Rasa Chintamani*.

After going through all references, it was found that; the method of preparation, dose, anupan and rogadhikar are similar in all texts. Only slight difference is in material (*churna*) used for coating of *Shankhas* in different texts.

Operating procedure is as: *Kajjali* triturated with *snuhikshir*, *arkakshir*, *panchalavan*; all filled in *shankhas* then coated with *pippali*, *gajapippali*, *chitrak*, *ushir churna*; heated for 1 *yaam* and finally fine powder is obtained called "*Kaphakunjar Rasa*"

As our classics consider, "Loknath Rasa" under both kharaliya rasayan as well as pottali kalpana; same way can be consider about "Kaphakunjar Rasa"?

This study gives literary review of "Kaphakunjar Rasa"

#### **Introduction:**

Literary review is the backbone of science especially when we are concerned about traditional knowledge. It is the foremost step before dealing with any kind of scientific and informative study.

In this study, review of literature regarding the concepts and preparation of *Kaphakunjar Rasa* has been carried out.

Medicines prepared using *Parad* are called *Rasaushadhies*; which are more potent and effective in small dose.

Kharaliya rasa are the combination of herbal, mineral and animal products, so that we can have effects of all collectively in a single formula. Such compound formulations improve palatability, ease in oral administration and shelf life is also improved.

Such *Rasaushadhies* (Herbomineral preparations) occupies greater portion in therapeutics as compared to other *kalpana*.

Kaphakunjar Rasa selected for the present study is herbomineral preparation comes under "Kharaliya rasayana"

Heating is done for '1 yaam' in procedure but its not direct heating, all triturated material is filled in shankhas and then shankhas are heated. So we will discuss whether it is "Sagandha Sagni" OR "Sagandha Pottali kalpana" in later discussion.

Operating procedure is similar in all tests. Only difference is in added material and coating material.

In *Brihat RasaRajaSundar* and *Rasa Chintamani*, *Shuktimansa* and *Sipimansa* is added respectively in triturated mixture additional to ingredients in *Yog Ratnakar*.

In Yog Ratnakar coating of shankhas is done with Pippali, Gajapippali & Vaari.

In *Brihat RasaRajaSundar* coating of *shankhas* is done with *Pippali*, *Chitrak* & *Triphala*.

In Rasa Chintamani coating of shankhas is done with Pippali, Chitrak & Vaari.

# 2. Literary study of operating procedure:

Preliminary step as shodhan of *Parad*, *Gandhak* and *Shankha* is done.

Kajjali <sup>4</sup> preparation using sambhag sh. Parad & sh. Gandhak done. Then snuhikshir, Arkakshir <sup>6</sup> added to it and again trituration done after adding panchalavan <sup>8</sup>. Whole triturated mixture filled in shankhas & shankhas coated with pippali/ Gajapippali/ Vaari etc. then shankhas heated for 1 yama & triturated to make fine powder of it called as Kapha Kunjar Rasa

Dose, Anupan & Rogadhikar: Kapha Kunjar Rasa in ardhagunj matra along with karpur and nagavalliswaras cures five types of all shwas,kaas & Hridroga.

# 3. Literary study of *Kharaliya Rasayana*:

Kharaliya Rasayana is widely used dosage form. Literary meaning of

Kharaliya *Rasayana* is *Rasaushadhies* prepared in *Kharal*. It includes procedures like *bhavana*, *mardan* etc.

Bhavana dravyas <sup>5</sup> may be various juices/ decoctions used to form *churna* or *vati*.

Mardan is very important. It involves pressure, friction and motion by which material becomes fine. Heat generated during friction makes proper mixing resulting in increase of its stability and potency.

## 4. Literary study of *Pottali kalpana*:

Pottali can be defined as collection of scattered materials into compact and comprehensive size in short the processing which gives compactness to the scattered material.

No reference of *pottali* found in vedic literature. In *Charak samhita* <sup>9</sup>, *swedan pottali* and *Rakshoghna dravya pottali* reference is found. No special reference found in *Sushrut Samhita* <sup>14</sup>. Some references found in Vagbhat in various diseases.

Uptill then *pottali* keeps resemblance with the pouch having some herbal/ other drugs and not indicated as separate *kalpana*.

The first reference as *kalpana*/pharmaceutical technique is found in *RasaRatnakar* of Nityanand in 12<sup>th</sup> A.D. mentioned in two types as

a) Ratnagarbha Pottali b) Shankha Garbha Pottali

Then after different pottali kalpanas mentioned in different texts like Rasaprakash Sudhakar <sup>12</sup>, Rasratna Samuchaya <sup>11</sup>, Sharangdhar samhita, Bhaishajya Ratnavali etc.

# 5. Detailed literary study about Agnimatra / Pachan of shankhas:

For pachan of coated shankhas "Prajwalayet Yaamamatram" is the only thing mentioned in original text. It means pachan with agni for 3 hours. As fine powder of shankhas is expected in final product; pachan of shankhas should be done in puta only.

As per our classics, in preparation of *Shankha Bhasma* '*Gajaputa*' is needed. So detailed pharmaceutical and analytical study should be done to decide *agnimatra*.

#### **Discussion:**

- According to all references main ingredients are same with slight differences in added material and coating material which we have discussed earlier.
- Parad shodhan, Gandhak shodhan, Shankha shodhan should be done as per standard procedures.
- Preliminary step is preparation of Kajjali using sambhag Parad & Gandhak.
- *Kajjali* increases shelf life of drug, gives bacteriostatic action and acts as catalyst to enhance property of herbal drugs.
- Snuhikshir, Arkakshir are common in all texts .Shuktimansa in Brihat rasa raj sundar and Sipimansa in Rasa chintamani is added to the mixture for trituration.
- Panchalavan —Saindhav,
  Samudra, Souvarchala and Bida are common. Fifth lavana is
  Romak/Audbhid according to different texts.

- In coating material, *Pippali* and *Gajapippali* is common and *Chitrak / Triphala churna* are added according to *Brihat RasaRajaSundar* & *Rasa chintamani*.
- For pachan of shankhas 1 yaam agni is mentioned. Gajaputa can be used for making fine powder of shankhas i.e. Shankha Bhasma. Further study should be done to standardize Agnimatra.
- After going through all references of *Kaphakunjar Rasa*, we can see, method of preparation of *Kaphakunjar Rasa* is almost similar as that of *Loknath Rasa*; only change is prepared material has to be filled in *shankha* instead of cowries.
- As our classics considered
   Loknath Ras under both pottali
   kalpana as well as Kharaliya
   Rasayan.
- I slightly dare to say *Kaphakunjar Rasa* can also be considered under both *pottali* as well as *Kharaliya Rasayan* on the basis of similarity in method of preparation.
- Dose, Anupan & Rogadhikar similar in all references i.e. ardhagunj matra of Kaphakunjar Rasa along with Karpura and Nagavallipatraswaras cures five types of all shwas, kaas & Hridrog.

#### **Conclusion:**

• Total 3 references of *Kaphakunjar Rasa* have been found in Ayurvedic classics.

- Slight difference in ingredients of different references has been found.
- Operating procedure, dose, anupan found same in all text references
- Kaphakunjar Rasa is useful in all five types of shwas/kaas and hridrog
- The term "Prajwalayet Yaamamatram" can be interpreted as pachan of shankhas with Gajaputa only.
- This is all about literary review of *Kaphakunjar Rasa*.
- Finally to standardize the procedure used for preparation of Kaphakunjar Rasa, pharmaceutical and analytical study is essential and it should be done.
